- 1. This is an Antique Automobile Club of America Meet. The Show Field is open to only Preregistered AACA eligible vehicles. The owner may elect not to have the vehicle judged and still display it on the AACA Show Field. Any vehicle that has preregistered and is not AACA Compliant will be moved to the Driver Participation Class area.**
- 2. Day of show entries will be parked in the Driver Participation Class area and will not be judged. However, Recognition will be presented to top three entries.**
- 3. Special Parking will be set aside for car clubs who wish to attend and not be judged.**
- 4. All Vehicles on the AACA Show Field ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A UL-APPROVED, FULLY CHARGED FIRE EXTINGUISHER READILY ACCESSIBLE.**
- 5. Ample trailer parking on site is available, No Overnight Camping at the Fairgrounds**

Car Show, Swap Meet and Car Corral Rules

The HFRAACA Swap Meet is strictly for Auto, Transportation, Steam & Gasoline Power Plant, Antique Tools, and Farm Equipment, parts, accessories, and certain automotive related items may be sold.

1. Period correct original and reproduction clothing is allowed.
2. At least 75% of items provided by vendors must be period correct and related to auto, transportation, steam & gas, or antique tools.
3. Furniture, modern crafts, modern jewelry, or house wares are not permitted.
4. HFRAACA reserves the right to expel, after suitable warning, any persons including vendors who conduct themselves in a way that would reflect unfavorably upon the HFRAACA.
5. Alcoholic beverage consumption on the premises is prohibited.
6. For the safety of our visitors and members, no motorbikes, scooters, mini-bikes, motorcycles, 2 or 3-wheel bicycles, or private, motorized carts are allowed to operate on meet grounds, except registered show vehicles, ADA scooters or carts and official vehicles. During the hours of 10 AM to 30 Minutes after the conclusion of the awards presentation.
7. We also ask that all show (AACA, DPC and CC) vehicles remain in their allotted parking spaces from their arrival to 30 Minutes after the conclusion of the awards presentation.

8. Failure to abide by any regulation will result in immediate expulsion and possible withdrawal of future Car Show/Swap Meet privileges.
9. The decision of the Car Show Chair, Swap Meet official, or any HFRAACA Meet Official shall be final on all matters.
10. No refunds of space leasing price will be made in the event of expulsion.
11. Any expenses involved in removing equipment or merchandise from the Swap Meet area must be borne by the person or persons being expelled!
- 12. No Tents and Canopies permitted on or near the Show Fields**
- 13. Tents and Canopies are permitted only in the Swap Meet and Marketing Partners areas. MUST be secured and/or staked down,**
14. Cars on the AACA Show Field will be parked by class.
15. All Vehicles on the AACA Show Field ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN UL- APPROVED, FULLY CHARGED FIRE EXTINGUISHER READILY ACCESSIBLE. All others are encouraged to have a fire extinguisher.
